LIGHT CNR. GOOD- Street and Goodsell Lane to improve the lighting of the street and the entrance to St. PETERS RAILWAY STATION.

MARRICKVILLE COUNCIL. 3. THAT the letter from Marrickville Council, suggesting the adoption of a centre suspension lighting in Juliett Street be received, and they be informed the Council is not in favour of the central suspension lighting, and that the matter of any further lighting be stood over until the restrictions are lifted.

A. BROWN RE CENTRE SUSPENSION LIGHTING SIMMONS ST. 4. THAT the letter from Mr. A. Brown, suggesting central suspension lighting in Simmons Street be received and he be informed that the Council is not in favour of the central suspension method of lighting.

LIGHT IN ELIZA ST. TO BE ON EXTENDED ARM 5. THAT the light in Eliza Street near Eliza Lane be placed on an extended arm to improve the lighting at the entrance to the School of Arts.

VOTE OF THANKS ELEC. LIGHT COMS REPS. At the conclusion of the Meeting a vote of thanks was carried to Messrs. Richardson & Henderson for their attendance and the assistance they had given the members of the Committee, to which Mr. Richardson suitably responded.
