Belmore Street, Phillip Street, Cambridge Street, Alice Street, Wells Street, King Street, Newman Street, Linthorpe Street, Georgina Street, Federation Road, Campbell Street, Church Street,

and viewed the lighting in these streets and the suggested alternative schemes as will now be allowed and recommends:

RE TRIMMING OF SHADES & FURTHER INSPECTN.

1. THAT the alternative scheme as suggested by the representative of the Electric Light and Power Supply Corporation for trimming the shades, which will give a much better light, be adopted and that a further inspection by the Lighting Committee be made as soon as the Company has been able to carry out the alterations to sufficient lights to enable the Committee to view the altered lighting more extensively.

ADDITIONL. 100 CANDLE PR. LIGHT ALICE ST.

2. THAT an additional 100 candle power light be installed in Alice Street on the second pole from King Street.
