Your Committee has to report and recommend as follows:-

VARIOUS LOCATIONS VISITED & LIGHTING VIEWED

1. THAT an inspection was made of May and Goodsell Streets as requested by the St. Peters' Council, and it is recommended that they be asked to provide a light on their side of May Street near Fosters Building.

2. THAT two additional 100 C.P. lights be installed in Federation Road.

3. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in Wilson Street near the reserve at Erskineville Road.

4. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in O'Connell Street, near King Street.

5. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in Hordern Street near King Street.

6. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in Roberts Street near Federation Road.

7. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in Lennox Street, near Eliza Street.

8. THAT the central suspension light in Pemell Street be shifted easterly to the next post and that an additional central suspension light be erected westerly near Simmons Street.

9. THAT an additional 100 C.P. light be installed in Station Street near Holt Street.

10. THAT a 250 C.P. light be installed at the junction of King and Wilson Streets.

[N.B. Finally arranged as M.V.]

11. THAT a 100 C.P. light be installed in Newman Lane, between Union & Gowrie Streets.

[N.B. Not proceeded with]

12. THAT the reply to the question asked by Ald. Brannan is that wherever there is an increase in the general rate, a proportion of that increase is available for increased lighting purposes.

INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL LIGHTS IN O'CONNELL, HORDERN, ROBERTS, LENNOX, WILSON, PEMELL, STATION STREETS, NEWMAN LANE, & FEDERATION ROAD.

This is Page No. 1 of the Minutes of a Meeting of the Lighting and Health Committee held at the Town Hall, Newtown, on Sunday, 27th October 1946.

Adopted by the Council Minute No. 937, with the addition that the lighting in Wells St. from Commodore St. to Edgeware Road be re-arranged and another 100 C.P. light be installed in this Area.
