

Minutes of a Meeting of the Lighting and Health Committee, held at the Town Hall, Newtown, on Monday, 14th May, 1945, at 7.30 p.m.

His Worship the Mayor (Alderman S.A.Fleming), the Deputy Mayor (Alderman W.F.Bodkin) and Aldermen (Mrs) Fowler, M.L.A., Pawley, Portus, Bugler, Elvy, Greenup, Smith and Goddard.

Your Committee has to report and recommend as follows:-

1. THAT a conference was held with the Electric Light and Power Supply Corporation in connection with the proposed erection of a substation on land at Whateley Street recently acquired by them, and it is recommended that the Council approach the owners of land at the rear of 228 to 238 King Street with a view to purchasing vacant land for the purposes of extending and widening Brown Lane through to Whateley Street and exchanging the unwanted portion of this resumed land with the Electric Light and Power Supply Corporation for a piece of land approximately 10 feet wide to Whateley Street/^{and} an irregularly shaped allotment to the existing 10 ft lane to enable the extension of Brown Lane to be completed.

2. THAT the action of the Town Clerk in having rectified a complaint on the light at the corner of Station Street and Enmore Road, which was lodged last year, be endorsed.

3. THAT an inspection was made of the lighting in Marian Street which was found to be satisfactory.

4. THAT an inspection was made of the lighting in Metropolitan Road and it is recommended that a 100 candle power light be installed on the east side near Sarah Street.

5. THAT an inspection was made of the lighting in Juliett Street and the Marrickville Council be asked to lop a tree which is excluding the light from Enmore Road.


